



Northamptonshire County Golf Club – Open Competitions Conditions of Entry

1. Postal Entry forms must reach the Club Manager not later than **14 days** before the date of the competition and must be accompanied by the full Entrance Fee and a stamped addressed envelope if notification of start time required – Final start sheet will be available on the website. Please make cheques payable to 'NCGC'.
2. After the starting list has been published, ALL withdrawals must contact the Club Manager at NCGC in order to be replaced by persons on the Reserve list. Entry Fees will not be refunded for withdrawals after the closing date for entries.
3. Please note that entries are limited and will be accepted in order of receipt. Reserves will be allocated.
4. The attention of competitors is drawn to the local rules of the Club printed on the scorecard and to any other local rules posted at the entry desk on the day of competition.
5. Ties will be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 and 1 hole principle and in that order. In the event of a tie for the County Cup, there will be a "sudden death" play off using the 1st & 18th holes. In the event of a tie for subsidiary places, the result shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes in that order.
6. Competitors are reminded that they should play without delay as slow play may be penalized. See Rule 6-7.
7. The Club cannot accept responsibility for thefts or accidents. Competitors are advised to arrange their own Insurance cover against insurance risks.
8. In the event of suspension of play due to lightning a klaxon will be sounded and play must cease immediately. See Rule 6-8.
9. Current ACTIVE Handicap certificates will need to be produced.

Conditions of Entry Junior Golfers

1. Competitors must be under the age of 18 on the 1st January 2018 and must have attained a handicap of 24 or less for the boys and 36 or less for the Girls at time of entry.
2. The use of Caddies or trolley pullers is not permitted. Parents and supporters are welcome but we strongly advise that they walk at the sides of the fairways only and away from all competitors, they may assist in ball spotting but should not give advice.
3. Competitors are requested to observe a reasonable standard of dress and etiquette whilst on the course and in the clubhouse Denim jeans, trainers, tracksuits and round neck tee shirts are not permitted either on or off the golf course and caps should be worn with the peaks forward.
4. Please help your child to prepare for this event by making sure that they have all the necessary equipment, food, drinks (eg. Sun Cream, Hats, Water, Food and suitable clothing), Water is available on the 4th, 7th, & 16th holes.
5. In the event of a threat of thunder and lightning a continuous klaxon blast will sound, this will suspend play immediately, you will be required to mark your ball and then leave the course, a Klaxon will sound three times to recommence play, **failure to comply with suspension of play will lead to disqualification.**



6. The Club cannot accept any liability for injury caused to other persons by visiting players whilst on club property and all players acknowledge that they enter onto the course or into the club premises at their own risk and consent to the risk of loss, damage or injury however so caused.

**Competitors are requested to report to the check in 30 minutes before their start time.
A current handicap certificate will be required on the day.**
